High Performance Air Filters

I have **3** ea. **20"x20"1"** new air filters, rated **Merv 11** (pretty good). I am offering them for <u>free</u> to the first to ask for them. I bought this size by accident.



MERV 11 High Strength Diamond

MERV 11 high-strength diamond pleated air filters are internally reinforced with a wire frame to prevent the filter from blowing out in applications where the HVAC system may place increased pressure on the filter due to high velocities or high moisture. MERV 11 pleated air filters provide between 80% and 85% efficiency

for filtering particles between 3 and 10 microns in size (such as mold spores, dusting aids, and cement dust). They also provide between 50% and 65% efficiency for filtering particles between 1 and 3 microns in size (such as legionella, lead dust, humidifier dust, coal dust, and nebulizer droplets.

Florida511 Traffic Cameras

I always wondered if some of those traffic cam video feeds were available to the public. I did manage to locate the Florida511 cameras. Last time I checked, there were 9 active camera feeds, but see note below.



When you go to the site, you will see stills (snapshot pictures) that update about once a minute. Above the pictures is a "Show Video" button. Clicking on that will activate the live view of the traffic. I also discovered someone has remote control because I saw on picture swing around and zoom in. It then returned to the normal setting.

NOTE: You can also click on the 3 dots, then Show On Map, to see a lot more interactive information as well as a LOT more videos.


